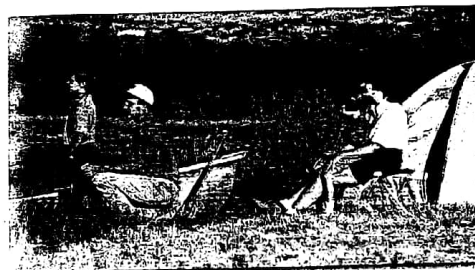

FROM SATURDAY NIGHT FEVER TO PRIMARY COLORS

Saturday night is a special time for everyone, especially for the young. Young people get together and organize parties or outings. Many of them go to discos. Saturday night is a magic time to meet new friends or maybe start a romance and many people talk about a special kind of fever, a Saturday night fever.

In 1978, John Travolta, the star of *Pulp Fiction*, was in a blockbuster film called *Saturday Night Fever*. The film was a huge success. It made more than 400 million dollars in twenty years from 1978 to 1998. John Travolta was 23 years old in 1978. He was much thinner than he is now. He played the part of Tony Manero, a young shop assistant at a hardware shop. Tony had a dull life during the week but became the king of the disco on Saturday nights.

Travolta is not very different from Tony Manero. He was born in 1954 into a middle-class family in New Jersey. He was the youngest of six children. His father was a salesman and his mother was a drama teacher.

There is an unforgettable photo of Travolta in *Saturday Night Fever*. He is wearing a black shirt and white suit and he stands with his right hand pointing to the sky.

Now in the late nineties Travolta stars in the film *Primary Colors* as Jack Stanton, an American presidential candidate. He put on weight and dyed his hair and eyebrows grey. Travolta has moved a long way from his old Tony Manero of *Saturday Night Fever*.

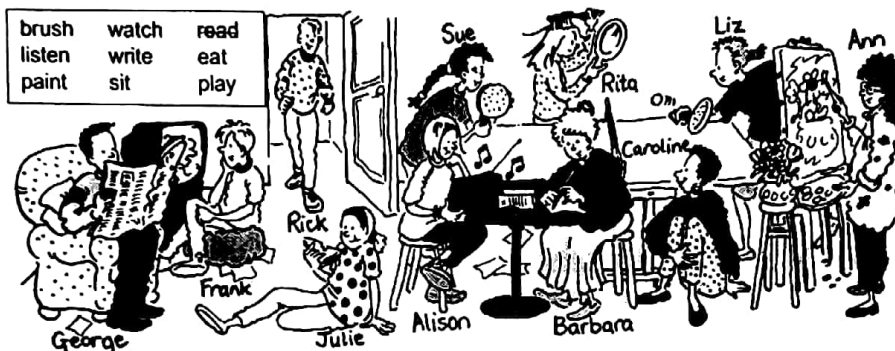
